

BACKGROUND

At Vincent, we recognize the vital role art plays in enriching communities and fostering cultural and social diversity. The Library Lounge Gallery, which is located within the City of Vincent Library, is dedicated to offering an accessible exhibition space for artists and community groups.

This space provides the public with an opportunity to engage with and appreciate a diverse range of artworks.

The Library Lounge Gallery hosts an exhibition every three months, offering four exhibitions per year. Proposals for exhibitions should present a clearly defined concept and be accompanied by images of the proposed works (or) examples of past work.

All submissions should be sent to library@vincent.wa.gov.au by the specified closing date. Priority will be given to artists from the City of Vincent.

EXHIBITION AND FITTINGS

Proposals should address the assigned wall spaces within the library lounge, with the option to utilise a screen for video works. Additional areas within the lounge may also be considered for exhibition purposes, subject to prior consultation and agreement with the Vincent Library team. Please ensure that any special requirements related to the exhibition space are clearly outlined in your proposal. A floor plan of the lounge is available in Appendix 1.

MATERIALS AND INSTALLATION

All methods of installation for artwork must receive prior approval from the Vincent Library Team. Please note that no nails, screws, blue tack, or any other markings may be made on the walls. The Library Lounge Gallery is equipped with a track mounting system, featuring moveable hangers and adjustable hooks on three walls, which should be utilized for the installation of works. Any video works must be submitted as digital files.

You will be required to meet with the Vincent Library team on-site for the installation of your works. At the conclusion of the exhibition, the gallery must be restored to its original condition, with all works removed. No artwork is to remain on the premises after the scheduled bump-out date.

PROMOTION AND SALES

Exhibiting at the Library Lounge Gallery is free for successful applicants. All sales will be managed directly by the artist. An A3 wall frame is provided for artist information, offering visitors the opportunity to learn more about the artist and purchase works. The library will host a small exhibition launch event on a Thursday evening. The City will create a promotional tile for social media and feature the exhibition across the Library's social media platforms and website. Any additional promotional materials will be the responsibility of the artist.

COPYRIGHT AND INSURANCE

The City reserves the right to document, or otherwise use any artwork submitted for the Library Lounge Gallery for promotional purposes without charge. The City will acknowledge the Artist as the author of

the Artwork and recognise the Moral Rights of the Artist in accordance with the Copyright Act 1968. The Artist agrees that the copyright in all artworks created in the course of the contract remain the property of the Artist. The Artist shall give the City a non-exclusive Licence to reproduce the images for related non-commercial purposes including publicity and promotion of the event/project, education and record keeping.

The Artist warrants that the Artworks and any Intellectual Property supplied by the Artist and embodied or used in connection with the Artwork is the sole property of the Artist or the Artist is legally entitled to use the Intellectual Property for the provision of the Artwork.

The Library Lounge Gallery is insured as part of the City's public art register.

HOW TO APPLY

Please provide the below material on the following page:

- Exhibition Rationale (200 words max): Provide a statement about what your exhibition is about.
- Artist Biography (200 words max): Provide a short bio. It may include who you are, where you are from, your educational background and your artistic direction and inspiration.
- Send us no more than six (6) of the best supporting images as JPEG files. Make sure they are smaller than 5MB each and captioned with the name of the artist, title and year.

Proposals should respond to the space in a contemporary manner.

Applications will be assessed based on:

- the exhibition rationale
- demonstration of artistic excellence and innovation of the works proposed, and breath of community appeal
- quality of artworks (supported by image submission).

All artwork and imagery is to be G rated and to contain no offensive material.
